Reading Room Tables:



The airy, three-story crystalline Reading Room is the heart of the new San Diego Central Library and serves as an inviting public penthouse for all San Diegans. Nestled in a three-story glass enclosure and covered by a sun-screening protective dome, this grand room provides a comfortable space for library guests to read, relax and enjoy panoramic views of the San Diego Bay and City skyline. In the center of the Reading Room are large reading tables with built in lamps that seat six people.

Contribution: \$25,000

Study Rooms:

Designed to enhance Library guests' connection to information and each other, these dynamic spaces are WiFi enabled and provide users with electrical access. There are multiple, small Study Rooms in visible locations on several floors throughout the Library. Small Study Rooms are ideal for two people to work on homework or hold a one-on-one meeting.

Contribution: \$25,000

Study Carrels and Computer Workstations:



The San Diego Central Library will bridge the technological and digital divide by maximizing public access to computers and technology training with more than 400 computers, laptops and free WiFi access throughout the building. Individual study carrels and computer workstations, many with beautiful bay and courtyard views, provide places for quiet study.

Contribution: \$10,000

Cozy Reading Areas:

The new Library offers many Cozy Reading Areas for individuals and small groups to gather or work independently. They provide stunning views of the City skyline or the building's expansive Lobby. There are multiple, beautiful Cozy Reading Areas in visible locations on several floors throughout the building.

Contribution: \$10,000

Garden Courtyard Benches:



The Garden Courtyard lies between the Auditorium and the Library's Main Entrance. During mild weather, large glass doors open to the Library and Auditorium, connecting the three areas and creating a unique, fluid space with benches for guests to relax with a book or cup of coffee. The shaded courtyard will serve as a much-needed town square in San Diego – a large, adaptable space to host brown-bag concerts, author talks, civic events or more intimate gatherings.

Contribution: \$5,000

Auditorium Chairs:



The striking, stand-alone Auditorium is the first structure visitors see when they arrive at the San Diego Central Library. The state-of-the-art theater, performance space and lecture hall seats 350 guests and provides an impressive public presentation space. With a sloped floor, expansive stage and state-of-the-art technology, the auditorium is designed for author talks, music performances, film screenings, dance and theater performances, lectures, classes and special City meetings.

Contribution: \$2,500 each or 5 chairs for \$10,000
